The Tayside and Central Scotland Transport Partnership (TACTRAN) is one of seven statutory Regional Transport Partnerships which were created under the Transport (Scotland) Act 2005 to oversee the strategic planning and delivery of transport at a regional level. TACTRAN lies at the heart of Scotland's transport network and covers the Angus, Dundee City, Perth & Kinross and Stirling Council areas. We have recently submitted our 15 year Regional Transport Strategy to the Scottish Executive for approval.

We are seeking to appoint two experienced and highly motivated senior managers to play key roles in delivering our Strategy.

STRATEGY MANAGER

The Regional Transport Strategy is the statutory transport policy and delivery document for the region, covering all modes of transport. You will have responsibility for developing and monitoring the Strategy, including formulating sub-strategies covering Walking & Cycling, Buses, Freight and other modes. This will involve extensive consultation and working in partnership with a wide range of key stakeholders, including partner Councils, Health Boards, Transport Scotland, other Regional Transport Partnerships and local groups. Educated to degree level in a transportation or engineering related discipline, you will also have a relevant professional qualification and post-qualifying experience in a transport related discipline.

PROJECTS MANAGER

The Regional Transport Strategy includes nearly 80 specified interventions aimed at improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the transport system. Delivering the Strategy will cost an estimated £90 million Revenue and £623 million Capital over the next 15 years. You will have responsibility for developing and delivering Revenue and Capital programmes for these Strategy projects, working with partner Councils, Transport Scotland, transport providers and the wider public and private sector. Educated to degree level in a transportation or engineering discipline, you will also have a relevant professional qualification and experience in planning and delivering major transport projects.
